- ◆ involvement in evangelism and missions

OUR MINISTRIES

By building relationships and welcoming people into our church community, we hope to share the love and transforming power of Jesus Christ. We invite you to participate in the ministries of RPC and discover the opportunities to know Christ and grow as a disciple.

Children’s Ministry

Children are important to God and important to us. Through the covenant of grace, our children have received glorious promises of salvation through faith in Christ. Our desire is to assist parents in the spiritual nurture of their children and introduce children outside the church to Jesus. On Sunday mornings we offer nursery for infants and toddlers, and Sunday school for pre-K through 5th grade.

Youth Ministry

The youth ministry seeks to assist, support, and encourage families in developing young men and women with a heart for God. There are Sunday school classes for middle and high school youth, as well as Sunday night youth group gatherings. Also, our middle and high school youth attend retreats, participate in service projects, and enjoy fun activities together.

Music Ministry

The overall goal of the music ministry is to enable the congregation to worship God through singing. We are not seeking to be ‘traditional’ or ‘contemporary’. Instead, we seek to combine the best music from every age with a balance of psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs that magnify God and communicate the wonder of the gospel. Our music ministry is a mixture of paid staff and volunteers. There are numerous opportunities to participate as a vocalist or musician to help lead the congregation.

Community Groups

Community groups are comprised of roughly 8-15 people who meet in homes throughout the community during the week for Bible study, prayer, fellowship, and outreach to our neighbors. They give us the opportunity to grow in Christ spiritually and love one another practically. Through these ‘micro-communities’ people are given the opportunity to work the gospel into everyday life, build mutually supportive relationships, serve one another and local neighbors, and invite others to explore the Christian faith. Visitors are invited to participate in any of our groups.

Women’s Ministry

Our women’s ministry exists to encourage and equip women to minister together for God’s glory and purpose. Through mentoring relationships, spiritual growth opportunities and acts of service, the Women’s Ministry of RPC encourages women to know Jesus intimately, love Jesus faithfully, and serve Jesus fruitfully.

Men’s Ministry

The men’s ministry is vital to the life of the church to help define biblical manhood, build strong relationships among men, and equip men for their various callings. Through Bible studies, prayer, activities, and godly friendships, we encourage one another to grow into men of God.

Missions

We want to passionately pursue the mission of God to redeem lost sinners from every nation. Here are ways we seek to fulfill the Great Commission:

- ◆ Supporting missionaries all over the world through prayer and financial giving.
- ◆ Sending short-term mission teams to serve Christ in various places.
- ◆ Participating in church planting. Currently we support church planting works within the ARPC. Our prayer is that one day we will be able to plant a new church out of Reformation.
- ◆ Supporting campus ministries. The university campus is a strategic mission field. Therefore, we support Reformed University Fellowship at numerous colleges and universities.
- ◆ Local involvement in service ministries, such as Blue Ridge Prison & Jail Ministry, Hendersonville Rescue Mission, & The Storehouse, to show the love of Christ through words and deeds.
