SNL starts back up in Kirkside Hall 5-6:30PM each Sunday night in February and March.



The Old Story New devotional book is designed to reinforce at home what your children are learning from the Gospel Story Sunday School curriculum each Sunday.

The Old Story New devotional complements the New Testament curriculum for our RPC families to use during the week. The children will retain details of the lessons through repetition. If you don't have a copy and would like one please ask Sallye Lucas and she can order one for you. Our whole family was blessed by these devotions even when we had high schoolers, middle schoolers and one in grade school around the table. If you don't already have a family devotional time at home, I know you and your family would be blessed by adding this to your routine.

This devotional makes it easy to sit down with God's Word five out of seven days each week. If you miss or get behind just summarize and move on. Missing devotional time happens, just don't give up. Keep restarting! At the meal table you have a captive audience. Expect to read five to ten minutes, (read through it ahead of time and summarize if kids are struggling to focus), take five minutes for discussion and end in a prayer and a song. If everyone is "doing well" ask everyone to pray for something or someone specific. I know your family will be blessed. Enjoy!
